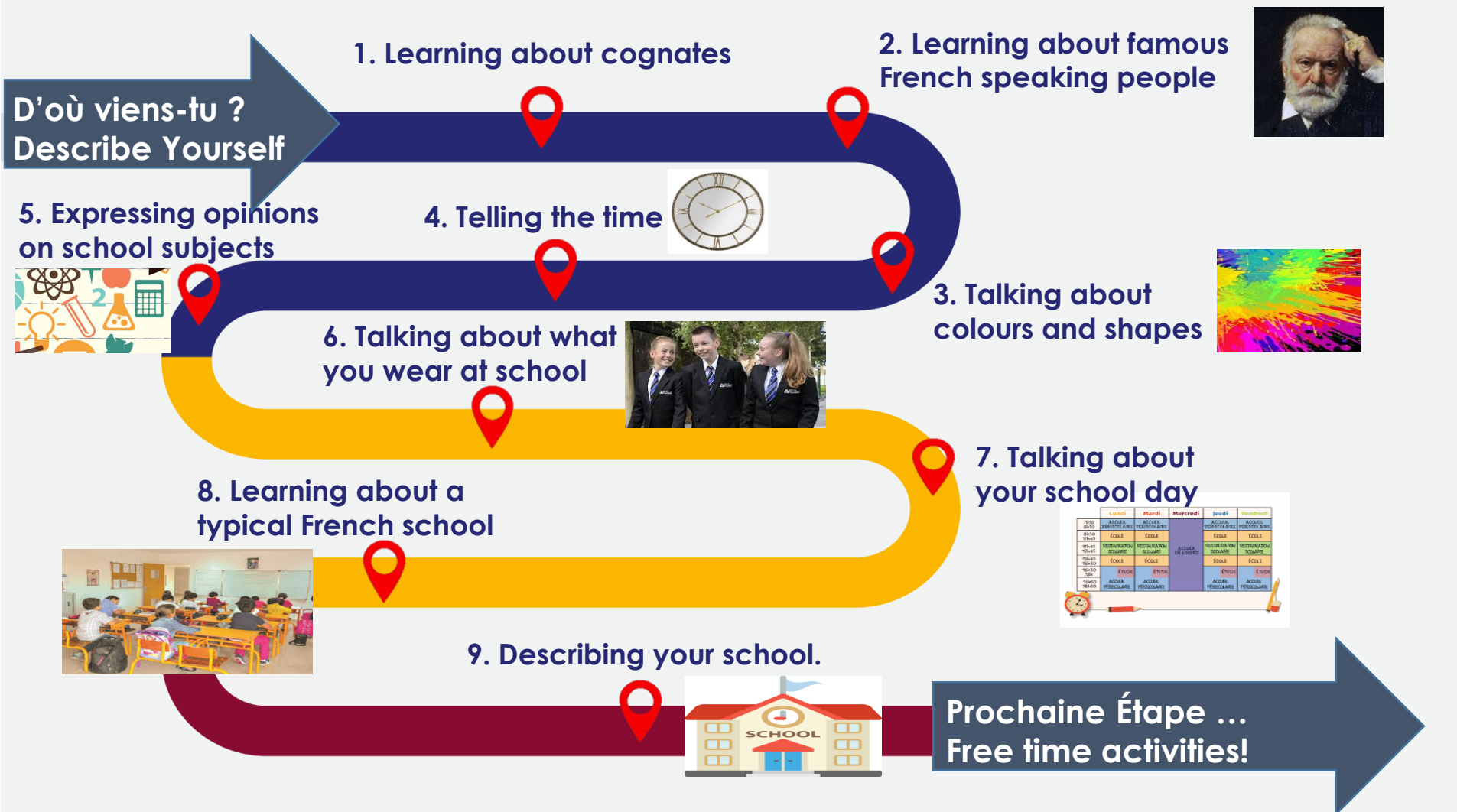




Why am I learning this?
