Now read the poem *Cold* by Carol Ann Duffy <https://genius.com/Carol-ann-duffy-cold-annotated>

Compare how these poems explore how nature affects human emotions. Write at least two CEDs.

Use GCSE Pod and your revision guides to catch up with any poems you have missed.
